CALL FOR COMMENTS AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON THE PROPOSED
NATIONAL MANUAL STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (MSOP) FOR FISH
WELFARE IN AQUACULTURE

The State Department for the Blue Economy and Fisheries invites the public to provide inputs on the Draft National Manual Standard Operating Procedure (MSOP) for Fish Welfare in Aquaculture.

The proposed Manual is pursuant to section 39 (3) of the Fisheries Management and Development Act Cap 378 on the development of guidelines and standards to aid the development of Fisheries Management Plans.

The object of the draft manual is to establish a coherent, enforceable, and evidence-based framework for the protection and promotion of fish welfare within aquaculture systems. The manual is therefore designed to strengthen regulatory implementation, operational practice, institutional capacity and sectoral sustainability in a manner that is practical, measurable and context-appropriate.

The manual will be useful to policy makers, standard developers, fish inspectors, extension officers, researchers, Producers, transporters, processors, consumers, input suppliers, insurance providers, financial institutions and development partners in the aquaculture value chain.

The development of the manual is spearheaded by the State Department for the Blue Economy and Fisheries (SDBEF) in collaboration with the Kenya Fisheries Service (KeFS), Kenya Marine Fisheries Research Institute (KMFRI) with technical and financial support from One Health and Development Initiative (OHDI) through the Africa Fish and Aquaculture Welfare (AFIWEL) Program supported by Coefficient Giving.

All stakeholders including government and private sector players, development partners and members of the public are hereby invited to submit their views on the draft proposed Manual. The manual can be downloaded from our websites www.mibema.go.ke, www.kefs.go.ke and www.kmfri.go.ke.
